DA's tips to avoid water and electricity disconnections by Joburg Municipality

Over the last few weeks there has been a steady increase in water and electricity disconnections by the City of Johannesburg municipality. History seems to be repeating itself with many ratepayers suffering termination of water or electricity supply as experienced in the last few months of 2010 and 2011. Very few of the terminations are due to default payers, but are rather the result of arrears accumulated due to unresolved billing errors.

After consultation with the National Consumer Commission, more than 3000 billing queries were handed over by the Democratic Alliance towards the end of last week. This is described as a victory by the DA in and endeavour to bring relief to the thousands of ratepayers with unresolved queries. The ANC led administration still remains unmoved and unsympathetic towards affected ratepayers and refuse to accept the queries form the DA. The Democratic Alliance is looking forward to the assistance and accountability the NCC's relief will bring.

Estate Agents signs are allowed outside the actual property for sale. Any 'AREA AGENT' signs on pavements can be removed.


REZONING NOTICES

Sorry to keep on about these notices, but when you see one - please read it, take a photo and send it to GARA.

The building of the 400 rooms on Austin Road is an example - an application did go into the Council for change of Zoning and a notice would have been on the gate for 30 days. There seems to have been no objections and the application was

granted February 2011. We know that the owner is now building 400 rooms for rent. No plans seem to have been submitted to COJ, therefore the building is illegal, but the rezoning remains.

The Council inform us that they cannot accept any objections to the Rezoning at this late stage.

WEBSITE OVERVIEW

What went Wrong?

As you might be aware, we've been experiening problems with the GARA Website (www.glenaustin.co.za). The site was hacked by someone who probably had nothing better to do and thought that he would just make live difficult for the poor person who has to do the administation for the site.

Yes, well... We ended up moving the site to a different host, reloading, just to be hacked again before we could even put the necessary security measures in place. As a result, we had to wipe out everything and start from scratch. After words, the site still screemed "malware" & "malicious content" by some Anti-virus softwares. We sourced a company to clean the site from all harmfull malware and malicious content and were audited by companies like Google and Norton Anti-virus, who have declared the GARA website as clean and save. However, the smaller Anti-virus groups, like Kaspersky, etc. do not have an "audit" system in place, and therefore, some Anti-viruses are still blocking the site. This will only be fixed once those Anti-virus softwares has been updated again, by you the user (so basically when you update your subscription and download a new version). There are ways and means to get past this, so if you need assistance, please contact Andriëtte - the Webmaster on webmaster@glenaustin.co.za and she'll gladly assist.

Again, we apologise for any inconvenience that any of this might have caused. There as still some aspects that need to be resolved and to protect the site from harmful content, some features were removed for now.

That's all from me, so until the next time please keep your eyes and

ears open.
